TENNESSEE TECH

- University's "front door"
- In addition to college majors, we are serving 38 undergraduate majors this semester in classes
- Participation of over 1000 non fine arts majors each semester
- 300+ public performances and art experiences per year
- 22 ensembles
- Only degree granting craft program in Tennessee and one of a handful in the United States
- 92% of our graduates are employed in their field or in graduate school within six months of graduating
- This fall saw the Largest marching band in university history with 216 students in 34 different majors with 89 freshmen!


