Elective courses allow you to hone specialized skills that align with your professional interests and career goals.

MBA DEGREE

OUTLINE

Tennessee Tech's MBA is a 30-hour fully online program consisting of eight core courses (24 hours) and two electives (6 hours). The core courses span all critical areas of business, including accounting, economics, finance, marketing, organizational behavior and leadership, information technology, data analytics, and business strategy. The 24-hour MBA core consists of the following:

MBA ELECTIVES

Students choose two courses (6 hours) as electives to complete their MBA program. Electives are offered in all areas of the business core including economics, accounting, finance, marketing, business management, and data science. Electives may also be satisfied by special offerings including international travel courses or independent research. Elective offerings vary by semester and include courses in advanced data analytics, services marketing, entrepreneurship, cyber management, financial statement analysis, network security, economics of health care, banking and financial services, and others.





ADIVISSION REQUIREMENTS



TO APPLY, YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING:

- A current resume. Make sure your resume contains dates for all work experience and degrees received.
- Official transcripts from all institutions where you took classes or received a degree. You may provide copies of transcripts to speed up the application process, but official transcripts will be needed to finalize admission.

FACTORS THAT MAY BE CONSIDERED IN THE ADMISSION DECISION ARE:

- Undergraduate GPA*
- Professional Work Experience
- Graduate Degrees and Relevant Achievements^{*}

The Tech MBA welcomes applicants from all academic majors. We do not require an undergraduate business degree or prerequisite business courses to be admitted to the program. Instead of prerequisite coursework, we offer a self-paced orientation experience that will allow you to start the program with foundational knowledge.

- * Although not required, we strongly recommend that you consider preparing for and taking the GMAT (preferred) or GRE if your undergraduate GPA is below 3.0 and/or you, have little or no professional work experience, as the results may weigh favorably on the admission decision. GMAT information is available here.
- Professional work experience is post-undergraduate professional or military experience and should be described on the applicant's resume.
- ^ Graduate degrees (e.g., MD, JD, MS, MA, PharmD, etc.) should be documented on the applicant's transcript(s) and denoted on the resume.
