
ORCID – Open Researcher and Contributor ID

SciENcv | Science Experts Network Curriculum Vitae


- Helps researchers assemble the professional achievements needed for participation in federally funded research
- Allows researchers to describe their scientific contributions in their own language
- Reduces the administrative burden associated with federal grant submission and reporting requirements
- Eliminates the need to repeatedly enter biographical and *Current* and *Pending (Other) Support* information
- Leverages data from existing systems





SciENcv | Implementation

- Slowly being adopted by Federal Agencies
 - NSF | Currently Required
 - NIH | November 2025?
 - USDA | Check solicitation

ORCID | Open Researcher and Contributor ID

- Began in November 2009 as a collaborative effort by academic publishers
- Designed to resolve the problem of author name ambiguity
- Currently has 10.4 million active researchers
 - Is now integrated in nearly 1,200 platforms or services

ORCID - What's in it for me?

- Your ORCID code links *you* to *your* professional activities and distinguishes you from other researchers
 - Your work is discoverable
 - Distinguishes you from others with the same name
 - When you're not *that* Dr. Smith
 - Remains connected to your work throughout your career
 - Even if your name changes, your ORCID remains constant
- Used as the basis for populating biosketches and other professional profiles *Including your funding history!*

ORCID – and Research Compliance

- ORCID (and other persistent identifiers) are being used by Federal agencies.
 - Why? To improve the discoverability and transparency of scientific data
 - Currently *mostly* planned, not fully implemented




Step 1 of 5 - Names and emails

Per ORCID's <u>terms of use</u>, you may only register for an ORCID iD for yourself. Already have an ORCID iD? <u>Sign In</u>

Step 4 of 5 - Visibility

Your ORCID iD connects with your ORCID record that can contain links to your research activities, affiliations, awards, other versions of your name, and more. You control this content and who can see it.

Visibility settings

By default, what visibility should be given to new items added to your ORCID Record?



Everyone (87% of users choose this)

Everyone can see these items



Trusted parties (5% of users choose this)

Only people and organizations you've given permission



Only me (8% of users choose this)

Items are private and only visible to you






ORCID | Your works

 While there's not a direct import from Google Scholar, you can use the BibTeX Export option in Scholar




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



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
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



