What We Do

Child Care WAGE\$® TENNESSEE is a new statewide initiative which serves to reward Early Childhood Educators for their higher education, as well as promote continuity of care for children during their formative developmental years. WAGE\$ accomplishes this in two predominant ways:

- 1. Educators who qualify earn salary supplements based on their current education level, with the opportunity to increase their supplement as more Early Childhood Education coursework is completed.
- 2. Salary supplements for educators means there is higher retention in the classroom. This consistency helps children develop more stable relationships with more qualified educators, all within a more stable learning environment.

Who Can Qualify?

A WAGE\$ supplement is available to Early Childhood Educators who meet the following criteria:

- 1. Work in a TN Department of Human Services licensed child care program.
- 2. Earn \$15 or less per hour.
- 3. Have one of the education levels listed in our Salary Supplement Scale. **CDA's MUST be submitted with a transcript** showing completed college coursework. (Credits must be from a regionally accredited school.)
- 4. Have worked at least six months in the same child care program with children ages birth to five at least ten hours per week.
- 5. Be employed at this same child care program when funding is available and a final confirmation has been completed.

How is WAGE\$ Funded?

This project is funded through a grant with the Tennessee Department of Human Services and Signal Centers, Inc. Supplements will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis as long as funding permits.
