<b>Code</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Definition</b>
10	Instruction Program	Programs offering credit courses leading toward degree. This code is for areas housing general-purpose instructional activities, which serve the entire program. All general-purpose classrooms are to be coded here and are the main area, which is applicable here.
11	General Academic Instruction	Areas assigned to departments that operate during normal academic terms. This is where most academic instructional space (except for regular classrooms that should be coded 10) will be.

14	Extension	
20	Organized Research Program	Areas with the objective of creating and disseminating new knowledge. This code is for areas whose primary use is for research. They do not fall into the two codes below (such as departmental research, which is not separately budgeted).
21	Institutes and Research	Formal research organization with separately budgeted accounts created to manage a number of research efforts.
22	Individual or Project Research	Managed within an academic department with a separate budget account. Can include sponsored research projects of faculty research grants.
30	Public Service Program	Provides services beneficial to groups external to the institution. This code includes areas that serve the entire public service program.
31	Community Education	Areas housing non-credit instructional services. Includes space used only for Continuing Education.
32	Community Service	Areas housing general community services activities which are not instructional. Includes Speech and Hearing Center clinic activities, Psychological Services Center, etc.
40	Academic Support	Provides support services integral to operations of primary programs. This code applies to areas that serve the entire program and do not fit into one of the subcategories below.
41	Libraries	All separately organized libraries. Applies only to Brister Library, its branches and the Law Library.
42	Museums and Galleries	Museums and Galleries
43	Audio/Visual Services	Provides materials to support programs. Does not include any labs that are part of the instructional process like language labs, etc.
44	Computing Support	Academic computer support activities. Does not include administrative data processing activities (63). Differentiation between the two functions must be made as much as is possible.
45	Ancillary Support	These areas normally provide joint support to instruction, research, and public service programs. Includes demonstration schools, etc.
46	Academic Admin. & Personnel Development	Provides administrative support and management direction to the primary programs. Includes Department Chairs, College Deans, and associated staff areas.
47	Course and Curriculum Development	Course and Curriculum Development

50	Student Services Program	Contributes to student's emotional and physical well being, outside the context of the formal academic program. This code includes areas which serve the entire student services program or are not covered below.
51	Social and Cultural Development	Areas which house student activities, organizations, intramural, intercollegiate athletics (must also have taxonomy code 7200), recreation, etc.
52	Supplementary Education Service	Supplemental instruction outside of the normal academic program. Includes remedial education
53	Counseling and Career Guidance	Includes Placement Services
54	Financial Aid	Includes student employment
55	Student Support	Convenience services for students, faculty and staff (if solely for faculty and staff code is 66). Includes student housing, health services, bookstores, etc. Taxonomy codes for Health Services must be 7320 and Housing Services 7330.
60	Institutional Support Program	Operational support for day-to-day functioning of organization. This code applies to areas that serve the entire program and are not specified below.
61	Executive Management	Includes President, Provost, Vice Presidents, Institutional Research, Planning, Legal Services, and other analytical studies.
62	Fiscal Operations	Fiscal Operations
63	General Administrative Services	Includes administrative data processing, functional program elements related to student records and staff personnel, etc.
64	Logistical Services	Activities established to provide procurement services, supply and maintenance of provisions, and the orderly movement of support materials fir the campus operation. Includes Purchasing, Central Receiving, Mail, Security, etc.
65	Physical Plant Operations	Physical Plant Operations
66	Faculty and Staff Service	Main intent of service is for faculty and staff as opposed to students. Includes Housing Services for faculty and staff, which must have a taxonomy code of 7330.
67	Community Relations	Activities established to maintain relationships with community. Includes Alumni activities, Development, Public Relations.
70	Indepentent Operations Program	Indepentent Operations Program
71	Institutional Operations	These activities are controlled by the institution but foreign to its mission. Includes rental property for income, etc.
72	Outside Agencies	Activities controlled by outside agencies but housed or otherwise supported by the institution. Includes WKNO, Opera Memphis, etc.
80	Unassigned	(Assignable area only) Not assigned to any program.
81	Capable of use.	Capable of use.
82	Incapable of use.	Incapable of use.
