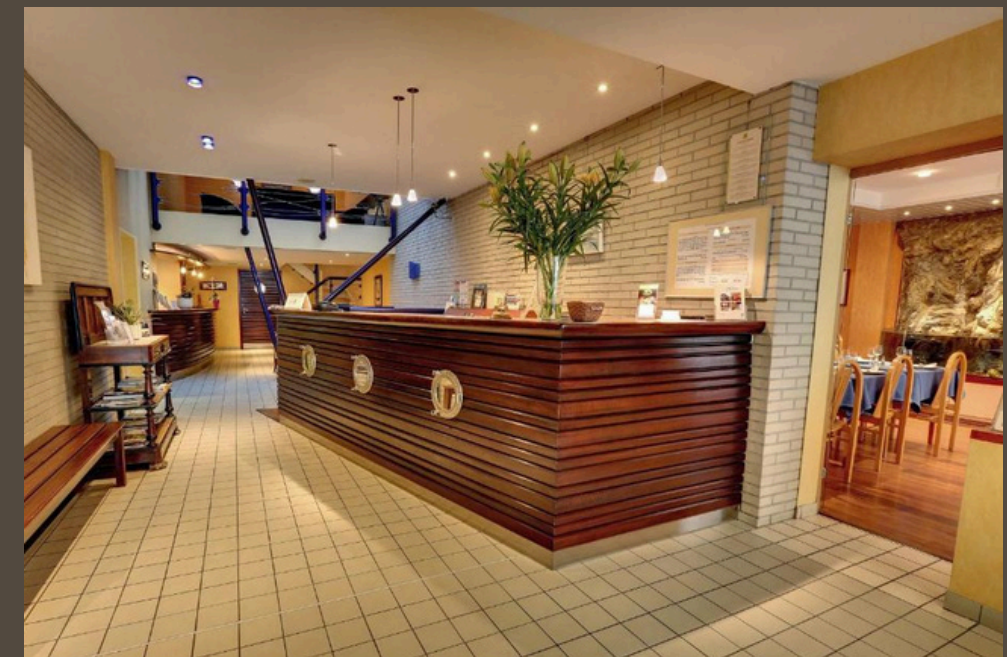

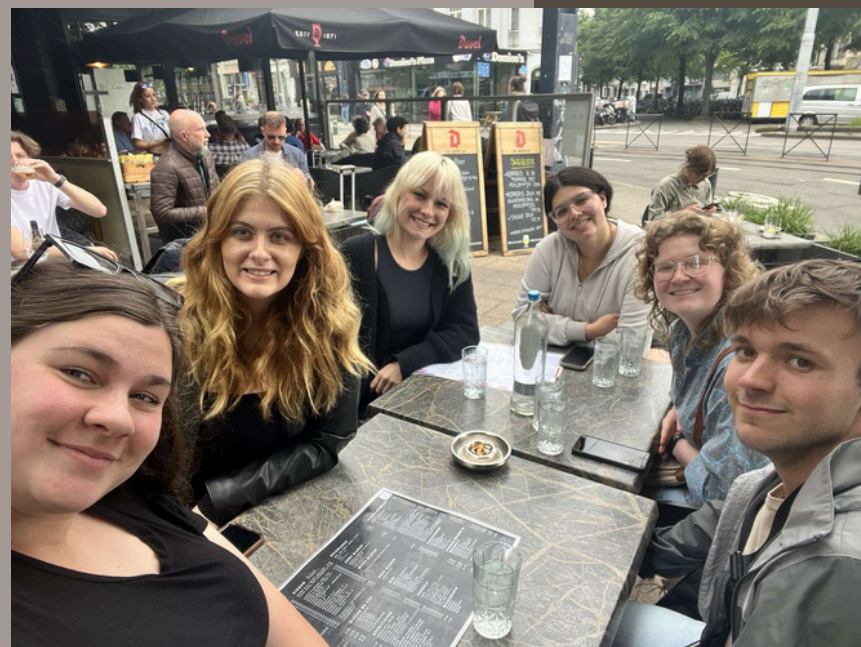


How Studying Abroad can help your future:
