### ACCESSIBILITY TIP OF THE MONTH

#### The Case of Power Point

- Use a large font size (18pt or larger)
- Give a unique title to every slide
- Include alternative texts with all visuals (pictures, graphs...)
- Avoid tables or use simple tables (no split or merged cells) with clear headers
- When inserting hyperlinks, call them something meaningful, not "click here!"
- Make videos accessible to people with vision or hearing disability
- Find more than one way to convey information – don't JUST use colors, as a screen readers won't notice them
- Use the [accessibility checker](#) to see if your content is read in the expected order, if the color contrast between text and background is sufficient
- When presenting, [use the automatic caption feature](#)
