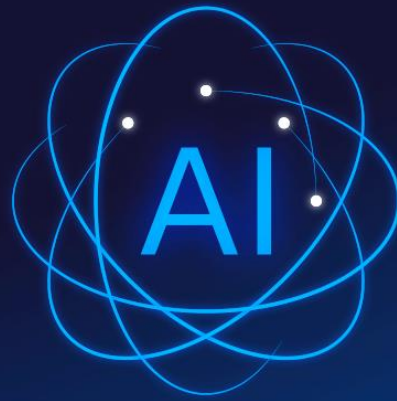

- Responds to creative prompts
- Answers questions related to specific, specialized topics that involve technical knowledge or skills
- Casual chats



Microsoft

Anthropic

- Excels at in-depth intellectual discourse across diverse fields
- Strong writing tool



Google

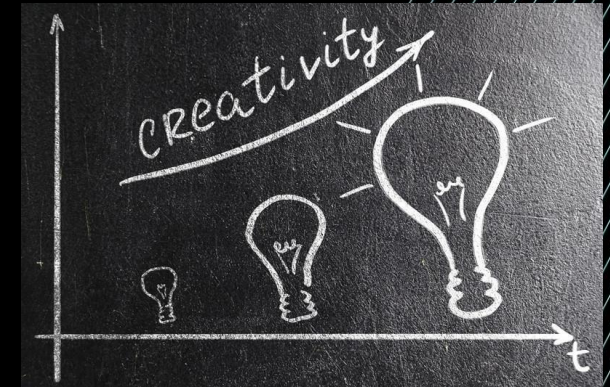

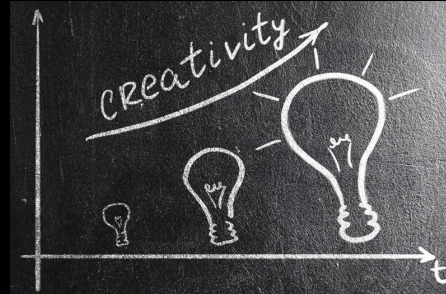

Get Solutions by Prompting CoPilot with an Issue

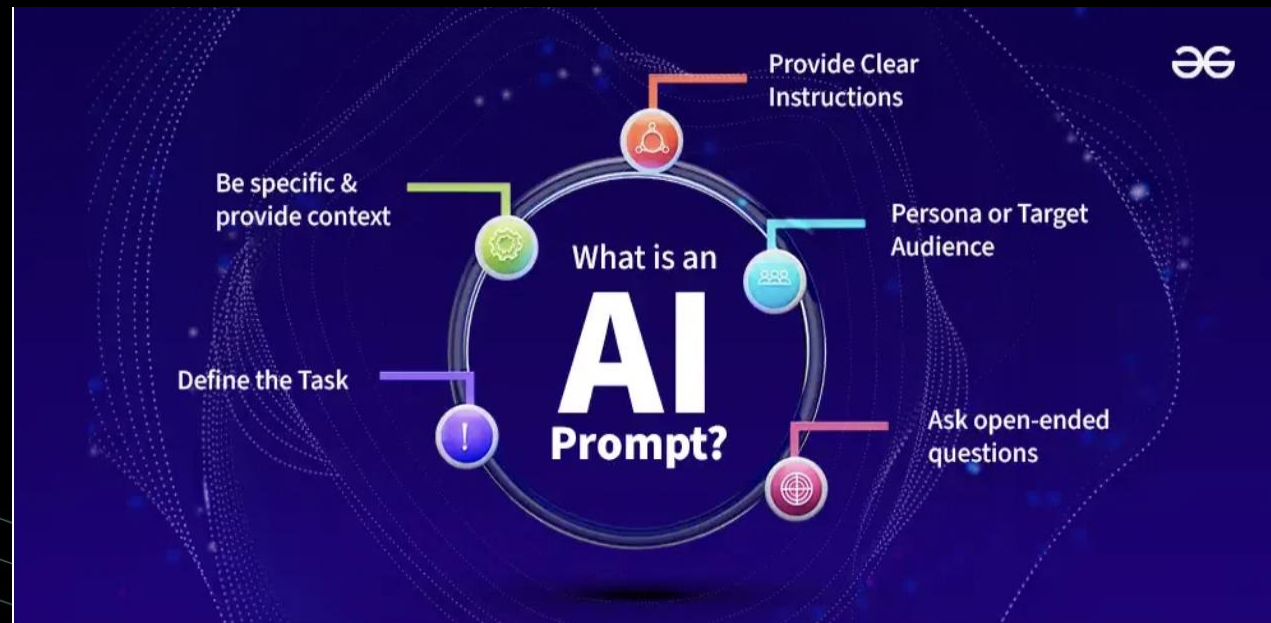

- **Project Management:** Struggling to keep track of project deadlines and tasks? Prompt Copilot with, “Help me organize my project timeline.” Copilot can then create a detailed project plan, set reminders, and suggest tools for tracking progress.
- **Data Analysis:** Need to analyze a large dataset but aren’t sure where to start? Ask, “How can I identify trends in this sales data?” Copilot can suggest relevant statistical methods, create visualizations, and highlight key insights.
- **Content Creation:** Facing writer’s block? Prompt Copilot with, “I need help drafting an article on remote work trends.” Copilot can provide an outline, suggest key points to cover, and even generate introductory paragraphs to get you started.
- **Meeting Preparation:** If you’re preparing for an important meeting and need to gather information, you can ask, “What are the key points I should cover in my presentation on market analysis?” Copilot can compile relevant data, create slides, and suggest talking points

What is a Prompt?

A prompt is simply how you ask CoPilot to do something for you.

Prompts Can Include Four Parts

Goal

What do you want from Copilot?

"I want a list of 3-5 bullet points to prepare me..."

+

Context

Why do you need it and who is involved?

"...for an upcoming meeting with [client], focusing on their current state and what they're looking to achieve."

+

Expectations

How should Copilot respond to best fulfill your request?

"Respond with a tone that is friendly but authoritative..."

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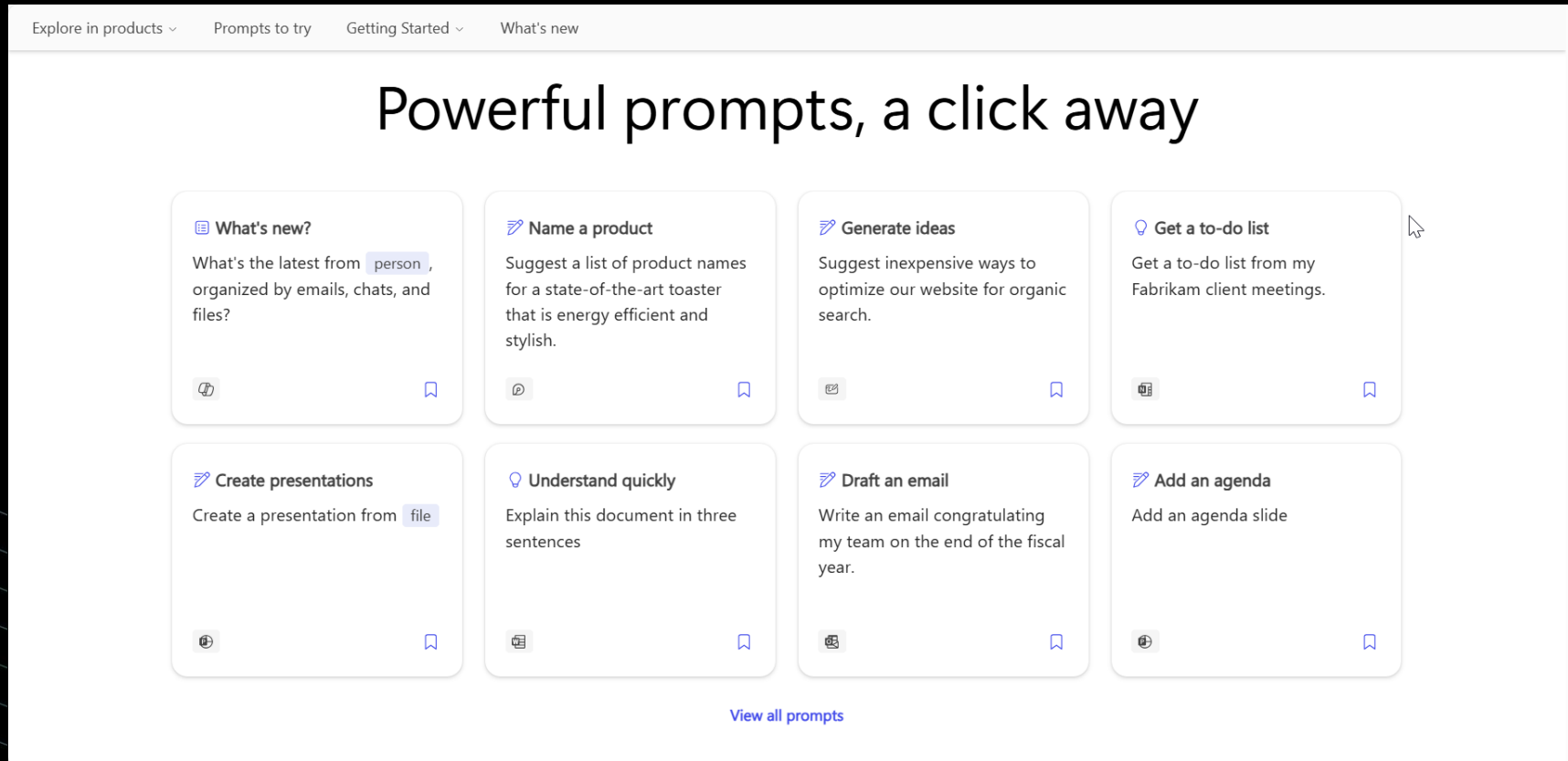
Source

What information or samples do you want Copilot to use?

"... and focus on email and Teams chats with [people] over the last two weeks."
