1. Call to Order

2. Approval of Agenda

Chairperson Election

It was moved by J. Baker, supported by L. Zagumny, and passed by voice without dissent that J. Wendt would serve as Chair of the Teacher Education Committee for the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years.

CI01. Undergraduate Course Additions and Changes (CAEP) **ELC** \rightarrow **TEC** \rightarrow **UCC**

Accept proposed addition of SPED 3001.

Accept proposed changes to ECSP 4871; ESLP 4200; ESOL 4400; LSCI 4570; READ 4570; SPED 3000.

Justification: Changes are requested to reflect current educational and professional standards, while remaining current and consistent with licensure expectations.

Discussion: J. Wendt shared that these changes may lead to an American Library Association (ALA) accreditation for the Library Sciences program. A. Brown asked the significance of ALA accreditation. J. Wendt explained that most public libraries prefer ALA-accredited programs and this could potentially increase enrollment in the program. M. Palk stated she had noticed a decrease in the librarian candidate pool at her school and insinuated that an increase in students in the Library Sciences program would also benefit the local schools and community.

Justification: Changes are requested to reflect current educational and professional standards, while remaining current and consistent with licensure expectations.

Accept proposed changes to ESLP 4200(5200); ESOL 6400; LSCI 4570(5570); READ 4570(5570); LSCI 6010; LSCI 6550; READ 6550; LSCI 6800; LSCI 7000; LSCI 7030; LSCI 7040; LSCI 7570; LSCI 7800.

Justification: Changes are requested to reflect current educational and professional standards, while remaining current and consistent with licensure expectations.

CI04. Undergraduate Concentration Deletion (CAEP) **ELC** \rightarrow **TEC** \rightarrow **UCC**

Accept proposed deletion of both the Special Education, SE Interventionist K-8 and the Special Education, Comprehensive Program concentrations.

Justification: In Fall of 2020 we established a new combined program that incorporates both of these programs. All students in the existing SE Interventionist K-8 or Comprehensive Program concentrations will have either graduated or changed their major to the new combined concentration by Fall 2022.

Discussion: M. Palk shared that she was happy to see this proposal and that the change would help with filling high-need Special Education positions at her school and throughout the district.

J. Baker moved to approve. L. Zagumny seconded. All approved.

6. Such Other Matters

J. Baker shared that there was a 100% pass rate on the required tests for the students participating in the add-on endorsement grant program.

The committee discussed trends in enrollment. A. Brown shared that there are currently 168 students enrolled in the job-embedded program and 130 enrolled in post-baccalaureate programs.

It was moved by J. Baker, supported by L. Zagumny, and passed by voice vote without dissent that the meeting be adjourned at 4:36 p.m. The next meeting has been scheduled for December 2, 2021.
