## C. Termination of SPED MS concentration (C & I)

Curriculum and Instruction is requesting the termination of the Special Education, Modified Program Concentration, B.S. and the Multidisciplinary Studies, Middle School Concentration, B.S.

Due to changes in Tennessee state licensure requirements for the special education endorsement areas, the current licensure area—Special Education Modified Program K-12—will be superseded on August 31, 2017. The Department has updated concentrations to reflect the new requirements within the endorsement areas replacing SPED Modified: Special Education Interventionist K-5 and Special Education Interventionist 6-12.

The need is due to changes in Tennessee state licensure requirements for the special education endorsement areas. The current licensure area (Middle Grades 4-8) will be superseded on August 31, 2017. We must change our concentrations to reflect the new requirements within the endorsement areas replacing. These new endorsement areas will be effective September 1, 2015.

#### F. SPED Comprehensive State Changes (OTE)

Job Embedded (Transitional) license programs were revised to fulfill the Tennessee Department of Education requirements for the Practitioner license with a job embedded experience and to better align

with the TTU post baccalaureate licensure programs. The Practitioner license with a job embedded experience program at TTU is only offered at the graduate level. Candidates are required to complete either a Masters or Ed.S. degree, as well as additional licensure coursework for program completion. Individual programs of study include:

• **Major:** Curriculum and Instruction/ **Concentration:** Special Education with Comprehensive K-12 licensure.
