ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission decisions are based on departmental review, using a combination of factors, including an interview to evaluate dispositional congruence, personal intent, and professional aspirations. *Satisfying minimal standards, does not guarantee your admission.*

Applicants to the program must:

- ❑ Hold a completed a master's degree in counseling. Preference will be for applicants who are graduates of CACREP-accredited programs.
- ❑ Have an undergraduate grade point average of at least 3.0 on the course work attempted and a 3.25 graduate grade point average.
- ❑ A 2.7 undergraduate grade point average, or 3.0 on the last 60 hours, may allow entry on a probationary basis.
- ❑ Complete a Graduate School application online, which includes:
 - a) official transcripts from an accredited undergraduate and graduate institution, as well as transcripts from any additional institutions of higher education attended and
 - b) GRE scores (less than five years old with verbal, quantitative, and writing component sub-scores). Students who have completed the 60 hours Counseling Program at Tennessee Tech are exempted from the GRE requirement.
- ❑ Applicants will upload the following supplemental materials to the Graduate School application:
 - a) Statement of purpose.
 - b) Resume contact information for three references.
 - c) Provide a writing sample with your application.
- ❑ An English proficiency equivalent of Level 9 in FLS (applicable to those applicants from countries in which the official language is other than English).
- ❑ Successful interview with the faculty review committee with a focus on dispositional congruence, personal intent, and professional aspirations.

ADMISSION PROCESS

- ❑ **STEP 1:** Complete a graduate school application form online and pay the admission fees online.
- ❑ **STEP 2:** Submit email addresses for three (3) letters of recommendation through the online system (see Step 1). Recipients will receive a request to complete the evaluation online.
- ❑ **STEP 3:** Request official undergraduate transcript from institution attended and GRE scores be sent to Tennessee Tech's College of Graduate Studies.

** Students admitted in Provisional Standing as a result of incomplete or inadequate application credentials, the deficiencies must be removed prior to enrollment in a second semester. Lack of test scores or unsuccessful interview will restrict enrollment to a maximum of 9 hours in the first semester.*
