What is the Elinor Ross CDF Freedom School?

A Children's Defense Fund Freedom Schools® Partner

Since 2019, the **Elinor Ross CDF Freedom School** coordinated by the College of Education, in partnership with the Children's Defense Fund, has **served dozens of children and their families** through this free six-week summer literacy and cultural enrichment program. *Scheduled during June and July, the school is available to Putnam County children, 1st through 5th grade, whose families qualify for free/reduced lunch programs.*

Named for the late Professor Elinor Ross, a tireless champion of education, reading, and literacy for learners of all ages, the Freedom School provides a host of engaging and interactive learning experiences in the arts, sciences, fitness, reading/literacy activities, weekly field trips to a variety of venues, and family-specific dinners and events. Participants (referred to as Scholars) are also given free age-appropriate literature to take home for their personal libraries.

Professor Janet Kesterson Isbell, who spearheaded the CDF partnership and served as the executive director for three years, has passed the torch to her colleague Associate Professor Amber Spears who has been an integral part of the program since its inception.
