New Business

CI05. Undergraduate Course/Catalog Changes (Multidisciplinary Studies)

- Motion and second to approve Curriculum & Instruction's proposed course/catalog changes to several Multidisciplinary Studies programs.
- Changes needed due to change in READ class required for licensure.
- Dr. Zagumny called a vote.
- All in favor; motion passed.

CI06. Graduate Course/Catalog Changes and Additions

- Motion and second to approve Curriculum & Instruction's proposed course/catalog changes and additions:
 - Changes: CUED 6430, CUED 6450, CUED 7510, CSED 6020, SPED 6120.
 - Additions: CUED 7540.

CI07. Graduate Certificate Name Change

- Motion and second to approve Curriculum & Instruction's proposed certificate name change. *"Online Teaching and Design"* certificate to be changed to *"Instructional Design and Virtual Teaching"* certificate.
- The educational technology concentration at Tennessee Tech has been in place for ten years, but the nature of educational technology has shifted greatly, creating a need for updated programming and new innovations in education and industry. The skillset obtained within this updated certificate is highly sought after in industry, education, and government.

CI08. New Graduate Degree Program – *Learning Design, Innovation, & Technology*

- Motion and second to approve Curriculum & Instruction's proposed creation of a stand-alone graduate degree from a current concentration.
