Discussion: Having these courses listed as directed electives causes issues for students who change majors and/or concentrations, especially from exercise physiology, fitness and wellness and sport administration because they do not have enough directed electives left to complete the prerequisites for PT school without financial aid issues. Nutrition is not a prerequisite for PT

school, so replacing it on our program will positively impact our students by meeting the university requirement of 36 hours of 3000-4000 level credits and reduce the potential need for substitutions. EXPW 3500 could benefit students who need a 3 credit 3000 or 4000 level course. Vote called: All in favor, motion passed.
