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Retired Cookeville High teacher, assistant principal establishes scholarship for education majors

Tennessee Tech was always an important part of Katherine Ligon's life. She grew up in Cookeville and when it came time to choose a college, there was never any doubt that she would choose Tech.

Ligon would eventually earn her bachelor's, master's and educational specialist degrees from Tech as well as a doctorate in education from Tennessee State University. Ligon credits many Tech faculty who helped her along the way. She retired from teaching full-time in June of 2020.



Today, she serves as an adjunct professor for Tech's College of Interdisciplinary Studies and supervises student teachers for Tech's College of Education.
