

Deadlines

As we quickly approach Praxis deadlines for the Office of Teacher Education, candidates may find it necessary to get one last Praxis attempt in via the "At-Home" test option. Please take time to thoroughly read the list of technology requirements, review space requirements, and ensure your internet connection is reliable. Past candidates have experienced issues with all three. Candidates can **NOT** take an at-home test on campus due to TTU's firewalls. Failure to adhere to the requirements set by ETS and ProctorU for the at-home tests may result in a forfeit of your test fees and require you to wait the mandatory 28 day retake period even if an actual test attempt was never made.

Candidates also need to be sure and review all policies regarding at home test (food/drink regulations, unscheduled breaks, dress code, etc.).

IF you were to experience any issues during your testing period and are uncomfortable with your attempt (spotty internet, technology issues, etc.), do NOT submit your scores at the conclusion of your test and contact ETS customer service for further assistance.

Interactive Practice Tests!

OTE offers Praxis[®] Interactive Practice Tests (IPTs) from ETS. These are full -length practice tests that allow you to answer one set of test questions to simulate what you will experience on the actual day of the exam. You can practice using authentic test questions and, after completing the practice test, view your results by content category along with the correct answers and explanations for each correct answer.

Interactive practice tests are **free**! The Office of Teacher Education can accommodate individuals and groups! Interactive practice tests are completed virtually and can take 2 to 3.5 hours.
