Interactive Practice Tests!

OTE offers Praxis[®] Interactive Practice Tests (IPTs) from ETS. These are full-length practice tests that allow you to answer one set of test questions to simulate what you will experience on the actual day of the test. You can practice using authentic test questions and, after completing the practice test, view your results by content.

Interactive practice tests are **free**! We can accommodate individuals and groups! Interactive practice tests are completed virtually and take anywhere from 2 to 3.5 hours. Availability may be limited.

IMPORTANT Praxis Changes Effective 8/31/22

Candidates who <u>have passed</u> the exam with previous test codes, 5169 or 5161, can disregard. Candidates who <u>have not taken/passed</u> the exam by 8/31/22, will need to register for and pass the new codes (see below).

- The Middle School Math Praxis has changed from test 5169 to test 5164. Students who have passed the 5169 Middle School Math Praxis by 8/31/22, will be allowed to use the passing score to meet licensure requirements until 8/31/25. Students still have the option to take the 105 National Evaluation Series (NES) test to meet licensure requirements.
- The Secondary Education Math Praxis has changed from test 5161 to test 5165. Students who have passed the 5161 Mathematics Content Knowledge Praxis by 8/31/22, will be allowed to use the passing score to meet licensure requirements until 8/31/25. Students still have the option to take the 304 National Evaluation Series (NES) test to meet licensure requirements.

The Integrated Early Childhood PreK-3 program only requires three (3) Praxis exams: Early Childhood Education (5025), Special Education: Preschool /Early Childhood (5691), and Teaching Reading: Elementary (TRE, 5205).

IMPORTANT: Candidates beginning their clinical experience (Residency) during the Fall 2022 semester **will not** be required to take the Education of Young Children (5024) and SPED Core Knowledge (5354) for this new licensure endorsement. If you have registered for one or both exams (5024, 5354), please cancel through ETS as soon as possible (https://www.ets.org/praxis/register/changes).

REQUIRED FIRST AID/CPR/AED CLASSES

Candidates entering Residency I and Student Teaching are required to show proof of valid First Aid/CPR/AED certification before entering their clinical placement. Candidates should email, fax, or hand deliver proof of all three certifications to Connie DeRossette at cderossette@tntech.edu.
