Start the process upon completion of 30 credit hours.

Deadlines for admission to the Teacher Education Program are as follows: Fall (August 1st), Spring (January 5th), and Summer (May 1st).

- _____ 1. Submit online: [Application](#) to TTU Teacher Education Program.
- _____ 2. Satisfactorily complete the [TTU Background Check Process](#) and submit the [VECHS Waiver Agreement Form](#) and the [Applicant Privacy Rights Form](#).
- _____ 3. Complete the online [Interview Request Form](#) and complete the [Teacher Education Interview Process](#).
- _____ 4. Complete the [Disposition Self-Assessment](#) and list **two raters** (two instructors; one education instructor and one content-area instructor).
- _____ 5. Submit **PRAXIS CORE test scores** or eligibility for exemption based upon ACT score or SAT score.
- _____ 6. Complete **FOED 1820 or 1822 and FOED 2011, or FOED 2050, or major equivalent** with a "B" grade or higher (Check with advisor).
- _____ 7. Complete **ENGL 1010 and 1020 or equivalent** with a "C" grade or higher.
- _____ 8. Meet established **GPA of 2.75 (excluding developmental classes)**.

 - _____ 3. Complete the [Disposition Self-Assessment](#) and list **two raters** (one Junior level education instructor and one practicum mentor).
 - _____ 4. Submit online: [Application for Undergraduate Graduation](#).
 - _____ 5. Satisfactorily complete the [TTU Background Check Process](#) and submit the [VECHS Waiver Agreement Form](#) and the [Applicant Privacy Rights Form](#).
 - _____ 6. Submit documentation of [CPR/AED/First Aid](#) certification that remains valid through the end of Residency (**online certifications not accepted for CPR/AED**).
 - _____ 7. Submit evidence of **professional liability insurance**.
 - _____ 8. Praxis II exams: To enter Residency, candidates must pass **ALL** required Praxis II exams attempted by the dates above. Official scores need to be on file with the Office of Teacher Education prior to entering Residency.
- Additional requirements to be completed prior to entering Residency:**
- _____ 9. Maintain established **GPA of 2.75 (excluding developmental classes)**.
 - _____ 10. Satisfactory completion of **ALL CLEP tests** and **ALL courses listed on Program of Study prior to Residency**. A minimum grade of "B" or higher must be earned in any designated courses by the end of the semester prior to Residency.

- _____ 4. Create a **TNCompass** account with the Office of Teacher Education Licensure Analyst.
- _____ 5. Complete the **College Base Exam/Senior Exit Exam**.
