Benchmark #1: Submit License Application Information

Complete Benchmarks 1 & 2 simultaneously.

1. Submit an Intent to Hire letter showing you have been or will be hired as the teacher of record by a school district in which TTU holds a partnership, academic year, and the occupational area to Ethan Grissom (egrissom@tntech.edu).
2. Complete a <u>Teaching License Application</u> .
3. Have official transcripts sent to Mr. Ethan Grissom, TTU Office of Teacher Education, Box 5092, Cookeville, TN 38505 or egrissom@tntech.edu .*
4. Create a TN Compass account and submit an "Occupational License" application. Select "TN Tech" as your university. You can find further instructions here.

*Note: OTE will forward your transcripts to the TTU Admissions Office for the university application. If you send transcripts directly to the TTU Admissions Office you will have to send a second copy to the TTU OTE office for licensure.



Benchmark #2: Admission to TTU

- _____3. Candidates must begin coursework the semester following admission. Contact Elora Davis (<u>eldavis@tntech.edu</u>) for advisement prior to each semester.*

*Candidates must enroll and successfully complete advisor-recommended courses each semester to continue in the program. Candidates should plan on taking at least one course per semester.



Benchmark #5: Additional Requirements

1. Complete "Supplemental Placement" hours (20 hours in CUED 4780/6780).
2. Complete two (2) university supervisor evaluations in Year 1. Includes lesson plan and self-assessment submission.
3. Upload information and a copy of two (2) professional evaluations completed by the district during Year 1.
4. Complete professional development requirements in Year 2 & 3 (if applicable).
