Keep in mind that the Office of Student Engagement and the Greek Week Committee reserves the right to reapprove or alter this packet if deemed necessary.

General Guidelines:

- 1. All participants must be active or new members of a recognized chapter at Tennessee Tech University. Participants must be listed on the chapter roster to participate in any event. Participants must be in good standing at the university and their chapter.
- 2. Cancellation or postponement of an event due to weather or other circumstances is at the discretion of the Office of Student Engagement. Notice of cancellations or postponements will be made directly to each chapter's president via email and social media.
- 3. Greek Games sign-up forms will be due on April 1st. The forms are on the Fraternity & Sorority Life organization page in Eagle Engage. Additionally, we will be sending the link to all the chapter presidents.
- 4. Points will be determined based on the Greek Week events' participation and placements in events.
- 5. The chosen judges for the "can-struction" will be the primary judges. If you have questions about a rule or need further interpretation of a rule for the judging process, please ask and contact us via the greeklife@tntech.edu email.
- 6. Any inappropriate behavior against the Fraternity and Sorority Life spirit at TTU, as viewed by the Office of Student Engagement, may result in a loss of points, disqualification from the named event, or removal from participation in Greek Week as a whole.
- 7. All fraternity and sorority members participating in Greek Week 2024 shall understand that all activities relating to Greek Week are not to involve the possession or consumption of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal substances.

Monday 04/08:

Instagram Banner Competition (April 8th - 10th, 2024)

- Banners must be turned in at the FSL Office at 9 a.m. on 04/08/24, banners may be turned in earlier.
- The competition will begin once banners are hung on 04/08 and last until 4 pm on 04/10. Banners will be hung around the staircase banister in the RUC.
- Requirements: Incorporate the theme of 2024 Greek Week (Carnival Theme) and include organizations names on the banner.
- Voting will be based on comments and likes on the @tntechgreekweek
 Instagram page!
 - o 1 like = 1 point
 - o 1 comment = 2 points
- Points will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams. These points can be found in the point breakdown!
- If a team's post is evident to have Instagram bots liking the post, the post will be taken down and reposted. The previous posts comments will be counted, but the like count will have to be redone.

Penny Drop (April 8th-10th, 2024)

- Time: 10 am 2 pmLocation: RUC Lobby
- Guidelines for Penny Drop:
 - Coins = positive points
 - Dollar Bills = negative points
- Teams will be given the opportunity to table for two different 1 hour time slots for bonus points. A sign-up sheet will be sent out at a later date. If your team does not sign up by Friday, April 5th at 4 pm, those time slots not filled will be open to chapters already signed up to table.
- Points will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams. These points can be found in the point breakdown!
- Only cash and coins will be accepted. NO CHECKS OR VENMOS.

Canes Spirit Night (April 8th, 2024)

Canstruction (April 9th, 2024)

Time: 4 pm - 5 pmLocation: The Quad

• Guidelines:

- o Teams can bring cans to the Quad at 4 pm
- Construction will begin at 4:15 teams will have 30 minutes to complete their construction.
- Judges will vote on 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place canstructures. Points can be found in the point breakdown section.
- Scores will be based on structure, height, and creativity. Judges will be given a rubric including these things to follow.
- Entry Brackets: All teams who meet these, will automatically receive these points!
 - Level 1: 300 cans; 100 points
 - Level 2: 350 cans, 150 points
 - Level 3: 400 cans, 200 points

• Canstructure Rules:

- Food cans of all sizes may be used
- No pet food or alcoholic beverages are permitted
- Avoid soda/junk food; items should have nutritional value
- All food items must be unopened
- Labels must remain intact and legible
- Boxed/bagged food items are permitted but can not be damaged
- o No items can be expired

• Building Guidelines:

- Structure must fit within the area provided to each team
- Structure must be self-supported (no boards, tubing, sheet metal, etc.)
- Rubber bands, string, and wire are allowed but not provided
 - Must be taken off and disposed when done
- Nothing that can damage the product or its label
- Teams are responsible for cleaning and boxing items once the event is done

- Directly following the canstruction event!
- Teams will compete in 3 activities
 - o Kickball:
 - Each Team will need 10 members to participate in this game
 - Max 1 team
 - Ultimate Frisbee
 - Each Team will need 7 members to participate in this game
 - Max 1 team
 - Cornhole:
 - Each Team will need 2 members to participate in this game
 - Max 2 teams
- A rules packet for the games will be sent out closer to time
- Points will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams in each game!

 - Teams can have no more than 4 games, but each game hosted by the team will gain more points! Teams can choose how many + what games they want to host!
 - Game ideas need to be shared with the Greek Week Committee to approve by April 1st! It will be first come first serve.

- Each team will need members of their team to run their games!
- Participation in carnival games is a great way to increase awareness of your chapters to our non-greek community.
