

# **ENSEMBLE OF RECORD POLICY**

## MUSIC EDUCATION

The Ensemble of Record requirements for Music Education (Licensure) majors are:

- Piano: Vocal Track: University Choirs; Instrumental Track: University Bands, Orchestra, or Jazz Band
- Guitar: University Choirs or Jazz Band
- Strings: University Orchestra
- Voice: Chorale or Concert Choir
- Wind/Percussion: Fall Semester: Marching Band; Spring Semester: Symphony Band or Concert Band as assigned by audition

#### PERFORMANCE MAJORS

The Ensemble of Record requirements for students in the B.M. in Performance differ between Lower Division and Upper Division except for Composition\* students.

The Ensemble of Record requirements for Performance students are:

Lower Division (Freshman and Sophomore)

- Piano: University Choirs, University Bands, University Orchestra, or Jazz Band
- Guitar: University Choirs or University Jazz Bands
- Strings: University Orchestra
- Voice: Chorale or Concert Choir
- Wind/Percussion:
  - Fall Semester: Marching Band; Spring Semester: Symphony Band or Concert Band as assigned by audition

## Upper Division (Junior and Senior)

- A minimum of two (2) ensembles per semester is required of B.M. Performance students in the Instrumental, Jazz and Piano options. One ensemble of record is required of those in the Composition and Vocal options at the Upper Division level.
- Piano: The appropriate major ensemble (instrumental or vocal) plus Chamber Music as assigned by the piano coordinator
- Guitar: University Choirs or University Jazz Bands
- Strings: University Orchestra plus Chamber Music or Bryan Symphony
- Voice: Chorale or Concert Choir
- Wind/Percussion:
  - o Jazz: Jazz Ensemble plus Symphony Band or Wind Ensemble
  - Non-Jazz: Wind Ensemble (fall) and Symphony Band (spring) plus University Orchestra or Bryan Symphony Orchestra, or Jazz Ensemble as assigned by the advisor

### **COMPOSITION MAJORS\***

• Composition: Follow Lower Division Ensemble of Record requirements throughout the program of study.
