Pre-screen video due two weeks before audition:

- Each candidate must provide a link to a pre-screening video that is due two weeks before the chosen audition date.
 - o 90 seconds of a combination of monologue and a music theatre song
 - There is no minimum time for either the monologue or song but the video submission should be no longer than 90 seconds total
 - o The video link should be sent to wmullen@tntech.edu

Audition day:

- Two musical theatre songs of contrasting style from memory
 - An accompanist will be available. The candidate must provide sheet music (no chord charts) for the accompanist. All audition repertoire must be performed with live piano accompaniment (no tracks).
- Sight-reading:
 - o Candidates will sight-read a short melody in the audition
- Dance audition
 - Candidates will complete a group dance audition.
- Additional Information
 - There is no dress code for the audition, but you will want to present your best professional look. There will be time allotted to change into relaxed clothing for the dance audition.
