

Tennessee Technological University Graduate Teaching Associate Certification Form

This form is required before any graduate student may take full responsibility for instruction and evaluation in an undergraduate course. It is to be completed by the department with initial instructional appointment and kept in the student's personnel file. All transcript(s) and CV's and other required documentation must accompany this form.

Per SACSCOC Credentials Guidelines, to qualify as a Graduate Teaching Associate, the graduate student must meet the credential standards provided below:

- Master's in the teaching discipline or 18 graduate semester hours in the teaching discipline,
- Direct supervision by a faculty member experienced in the teaching discipline,
- Regular in-service training, and
- Planned and periodic evaluations.
