This program is based on the National Board of Professional Teaching Standards: Early and Middle Childhood/Literacy: Reading-Language Arts. It provides advanced professional preparation in reading and language arts and is aligned with National Board for Professional Teaching Standards' core propositions.

All students in this program must be fully licensed and currently engaged teachers. The coursework bases content and learning experiences on your work in the classroom, with many assignments you will undertake with your own students

Coursework

All graduate students will take classes focusing on theories of learning and development, best practices, teaching and learning strategies, assessment, handling literacy problems and research. All students will maintain a portfolio throughout the program. Successful graduates must pass an oral comprehensive examination based upon their individual action research projects.

Faculty

The graduate program's faculty members live and work all over the state of Tennessee and use their experiences and knowledge in their course content to provide mentorship and opportunities.
