- 2. Unless otherwise noted, all data represents 14th Day census counts for the Fall semester.
- 3. Program names, department names, and department affiliations are as of the most recent Fall term. Programs that were different in previous years are mapped to the current definition.
- 4. Minors have been grouped into colleges based on the last Course Catalog, from each College's website, or by our office's best judgement. The 'Honors' and 'Leadership & Military Science' minors have been listed under an 'Other' category.
- 5. Students may declare more than one minor. If a student has more than one minor, they show up once per each minor.
