Data Notes:

- 1. All data conforms to TTU internal reporting standards and may differ slightly from official reports provided to external constituents such as the Tennessee Higher Education Commission. Differences in reporting date can also cause minor discrepancies.
- 2. For comparability with corresponding measures at other higher education institutions, IPEDS general definitions for full-time-equivalent (FTE) faculty and students are used in this report.
 - a. Adjunct FTE Faculty values are calculated one-third part-time faculty counts
 - b. Student FTE Enrollment is calculated as full-time students equal one while part-time students is calculated as one-third part-time student counts.





Undergraduate FTE Faculty, FTE Students, and FTE Student-Faculty Ratio




FTE Faculty and FTE Enrollment Trends
