## Changing the iLearn Homepage Within a Course

This guide explains how to change the iLearn homepage layout within a course by selecting from existing options that include various widgets and tools.

## Changing the Homepage

- 1. On the purple navigation bar, click **Course Management**.
- 2. Select Course Admin.
- 3. Under Site Setup, select Homepages.

4. Click the drop-down menu under Active Homepage and select the preferred homepage.

- **TnTech-Course Home Fall 2022**: New Course Home template with Course Overview widget, Content Navigator widget, Slim Announcements widget, etc.
- **TnTech-Course Home MH Connect**: Course Homepage with McGraw Hill widget, includes Announcements.

- 5. Click Apply.

## Copy a Homepage

Instructors can modify an existing homepage by creating a copy, which remains private and accessible only to them, without being shared with others.

- 1. On the purple navigation bar, click **Course Management**.
- 2. Select Course Admin.
- 3. Under Site Setup, select Homepages.
- 4. Click the down-arrow next to the homepage to copy, then click **Copy**.
- 5. The new homepage will appear in blue text. Click the homepage copy's name to edit.
- 6. Change the homepage name, then add/remove any widgets from the homepage.
- 7. When changes are finalized, click **Save and Close**.
- 8. Click the drop-down menu under **Active Homepage** and select the newly created homepage.
- 9. Click Apply.
