Setting up Group Discussions

Note: Groups *must* be created before creating group discussion topics. See <u>Creating Groups</u> for more information.

- 1. Click **Discussions** in the course navigation bar
- 2. Click the dropdown arrow beside the topic.
- 3. Select Edit Topic.
- 4. Select Availability Dates & Conditions
- 5. Under "Group and Section Restrictions" select Manage Restrictions.

- 6. Choose from the two options [1]:
 - a. **Restrict topic to only selected groups**: Users in the selected groups can view this topic and all of its threads.
 - b. **Separate threads to create small group discussions**: Users in the selected groups can view this topic but will only see threads from their group.

7. Choose the group under Group or Section Category [2].
