Creating HTML Pages

HTML Templates can be used in an iLearn course within the Content tool, enabling the creation of accessible resources that are easy to read and edit. Instructors can add interactive elements and practices within HTML pages.

Using HTML Templates in Content

1. On the purple navigation bar, click **Content**.
2. Select the module where the file should be created.
3. Click the **Upload/Create button** [1] and then choose **Create a File** [2].

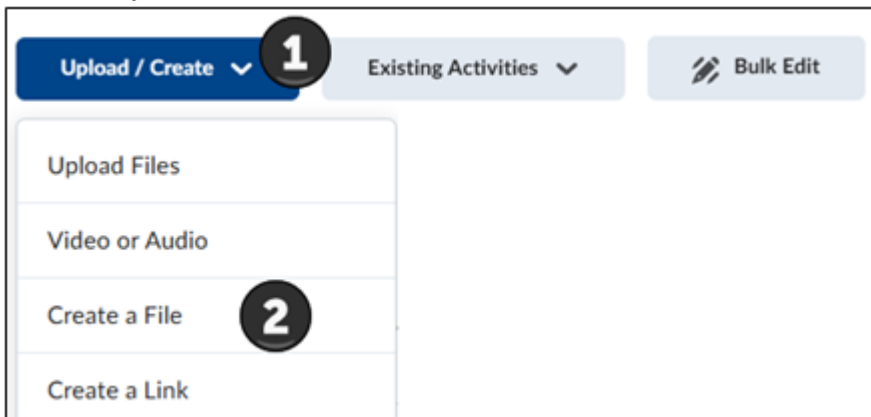


Figure: Create a file within Content

4. Enter a title.
5. (Optional) Use the **Select a Document Template** to choose a preexisting HTML page layout.
 - Content can be copied from another document or typed directly into the body of the page. If the document already contains defined styles, they will transfer intact and update to match the template's appearance.
 - The HTML Editor options enable adding links to other content. The Insert Stuff, Quicklinks, and Image icons allow for inserting media, such as pictures or videos, and linking course resources and assessments to the page.
6. When finished, click **Save and Close**.
