This document outlines how to use Creator+ Elements in HTML pages.

Creator+ Elements

Creator+ enables you to add interactive components to a Content file to promote student engagement. These interactive components are available in two options: Elements and Practices.

How to add a Creator+ Element

1. On the purple navigation bar, go to **Content**.
2. Select the module where the file should be created.
3. Click the **Upload/Create button** [1] and then choose **Create a File** [2].




Figure: Create a file within Content

4. Enter a title.
5. (Optional) Use the **Select a Document Template** to choose a preexisting HTML page layout.
6. Click the **Authoring Tools Menu button** [1], then select **Insert Element** [2].





Figure: Use the Authoring Tools Icon to insert Creator+ Elements.

7. Select the desired element type from the list.
Element Options: Accordion, Tabs, Click and Reveal, Callout, Timeline, Stylized Quote, Flip Cards, Carousel, and Hotspot.

8. Enter the information on the specific element screen.
