



# iLearn: Creator+ Practices

This document outlines how to use Creator+ Practices in HTML pages.

## Creator+ Practice

Creator+ enables you to add interactive components to a Content file to promote student engagement. These interactive components are available in two options: Elements and Practices. To auto-generate Creator+ Practice questions based on content in HTML pages, use Lumi.

### How to add a Creator+ Practice

1. On the purple navigation bar, go to **Content**.
2. Select the module where the file should be created.
3. Click the **Upload/Create button** [1] and then choose **Create a File** [2].




Figure: Create a file within Content

4. Enter a title.
5. (Optional) Use the **Select a Document Template** to choose a preexisting HTML page layout.
6. Click the Authoring Tools Menu button [1], then select **Insert Practice** [2].




Figure: Use the Authoring Tools Icon to insert Creator+ Practices.

7. Select the desired practice type from the list.  
Practice Options: Dropdown Fill in the Blanks, Fill in the Blanks, Multi-Select, Multiple Choice, Sequencing, Sorting, and True or False.

8. Enter the information on the specific practice screen.

9. When finished, click **Preview** (optional), then click **Insert**.
10. Click **Save and Close**.

## Lumi in Creator+

Lumi in Creator+ for is a powerful tool that uses AI to add interactive formative assessments to HTML pages where students can complete knowledge checks.

1. On an HTML page, click the **Authoring Tools Menu** button [1], then select **Insert Practice** [2].




Figure: Use the Authoring Tools Icon to insert Creator+ Practices.

2. Select a supported practice type. (All Lumi enabled practices have a sparkle icon next to the practice)




Figure: Current practice types supported by Lumi include Dropdown Fill in the Blanks, Fill in the Blanks, Multi-Select, Multiple Choice, and True or False.

3. Click Generate Question




Figure: Generate Question in Lumi

4. If necessary, edit the Source Text field in the Generate Question dialog. Then, click **Generate Question**.




Figure: Review the Source Text and click Generate Question.

*Note: If there is no pre-existing text on the HTML page, the instructor will need to copy and paste content into the source text. This does not alter the content on the HTML page, only provides Lumi with information to pull from to create the practice question.*

5. When the Practice question generates, review the question.
6. (Optional) Perform one of the following actions:
  - **Regenerate Question:** Click to generate a new question.
  - **Edit Source Text:** Click to edit the Source Text and then click Regenerate Question.

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- **Discard Question:** Delete the generated Practice question.  
If necessary, edit the Source Text field in the Generate Question dialog.
- **Rate Question Quality:** Select the thumbs up or thumbs down buttons to provide feedback




Figure: Review the generated Practice. You can choose to Regenerate Question, Edit Source Text, or Discard Question.

7. The question-and-answer portion will auto-fill based on the Lumi generated material. Edit as needed.
8. When finished, click **Insert**, then close the Creator+ dialog.
9. Click **Save and Close**.
