Narrative

Tennessee Technological University (TTU) has a history of continuous operation and student enrollment since its founding as Tennessee Polytechnic Institute in 1915 [1].

Establishment

Tennessee Polytechnic Institute originally offered courses at the junior college level and then was authorized by the Tennessee State Board of Education to offer four-year degrees, with the first baccalaureate degrees being awarded in 1929. Expansion in curriculum, enrollment, academic and student services, and physical plant led to university status, and the name of the institution became Tennessee Technological University in 1965 [1].

During the past decade, TTU enrollment has increased notably, exceeding 11,000 students in Fall 2010. In Fall 2014, TTU enrollment totaled 11,339, with 10,314 students enrolled in undergraduate programs and 1,025 students enrolled in graduate programs [2].

The University has awarded more than 2,000 degrees annually since 2005-2006. Celebrating the centennial year of operation in 2015, TTU continues to enroll more than 11,000 students and confer more than 2,000 degrees each year [3].





