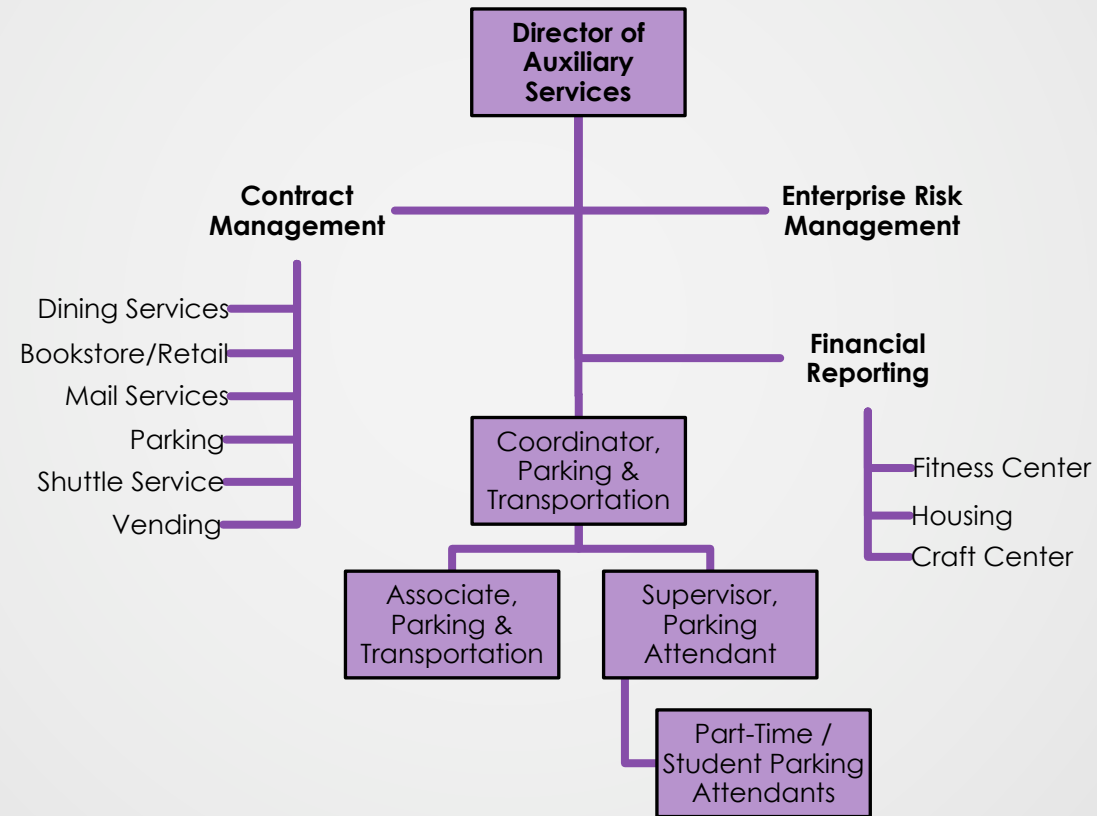

# Proposed Parking Solutions

- Put forward a student referendum to assist with getting an “all-encompassing” parking fee established.
- “Modernize” the current Permitting Process
- This will be an automatic process for students and a fee will be added directly to student account on a semester basis. Much like current permit or tuition is currently.
- Build New Parking Garage Facilities around campus.

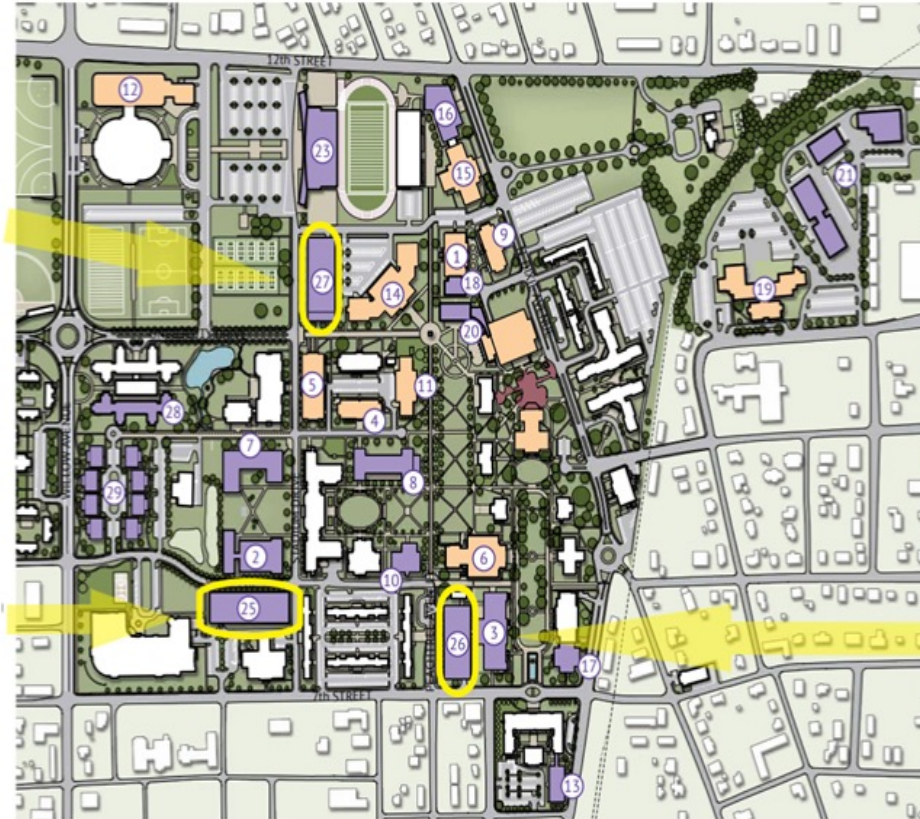

# Proposed Parking Solutions Cont.

## Proposed Parking Fee Structure

**Rolls out in Fall 2024 Semester**

**Fee would apply to all students**

**Fee would be split on a Fall/Spring Semester basis**

**Fee covers Shuttles, Shelters, Sidewalk/Traffic Improvements, Campus Bicycle Improvements, etc.**

**Increased Accessibility and Signage around campus**

**Introduction of LPR (License Plate Reader) Technology on campus to assist with vehicle recognition.**



# Proposed Parking Fee Structure/Breakdown

Fall semester 2024 – parking fee charged to all student      \$125/semester

Potential Construction Schedule – 18 months total

Design to begin                      7/1/2024

Construction to begin              1/1/2025

Construction completion         1/1/2026





# Next Step and Conclusion

**Finalize Marketing and Communication Campaign to communicate the need for improved Parking and Transportation to the student body.**

**SGA Approves and moves forward with Student Referendum**

**Vote on Referendum**

**Administration proposes Fee Structure to Campus/BOT, State of TN, etc.**

**Fee Structure approved**

**Begin Plans for Design/Construction of Garages.**

**Build Garages.**

**The STUDENT VOICE gives Administration the leverage and tool to explain the need for these types of projects.**

**Similar initiative was done for The Burn Rec Center a few years back.**
