

An Act to Add Multicultural Affairs Representation to Student Government

- Whereas,** the Office of Multicultural Affairs serves a large population on campus, **and,**
- Whereas,** currently there is no guaranteed representation in the Student Government Association Senate for these populations, **and,**
- Whereas,** ethnicity is an aspect of diversity and the Student Government Association works to serve a diverse population, **and,**
- Whereas,** Tennessee Tech strives to support all students and the Multicultural Affairs Office's goal of allowing all to students to be able to perform, in perception and reality, due to a welcoming atmosphere, **and,**
- Whereas,** the mission of the Tennessee Tech Multicultural Affairs Office is to provide support for the personal, cultural, social, and academic growth and development of students from underrepresented ethnic populations, **and,**
- Whereas,** the purpose of the Student Government Association is to provide a voice for all students on campus.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT

- Section 1:** This bill shall be known as the "Multicultural Affairs Representation Act of 2020"
- Section 2:** Two senators will be added to the Student Government Association Senate.
- Section 3:** These senators will adhere to and perform the same duties as the rest of the senate.
- Section 4:** These senators will be nominated by the Office of Multicultural Affairs and voted on by the Senate.
- Section 5:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.


