

An Act to Improve Student Safety in the RUC expansion

- Whereas,** the new RUC expansion provides a fire pit that has attracted a large student interest, **and,**
- Whereas,** currently there is no safety precautions in place regarding fire pit safety, **and,**
- Whereas,** there have been frequent hazardous actions from students on or near the fire pit, **and,**
- Whereas,** installing a plaque that informs students of surveillance can minimize these hazardous actions,

NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF
TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

- Section 1:** This bill shall be known as the "RUC Fire Safety Plaque Act of 2021"
- Section 2:** The plaque will reside on the outer flat edge of the pit.
- Section 3:** The plaque will inform students that they are being recorded.
- Section 4:** Plaque shall state *"Do not touch stones. Do not jump over fire pit. Surveillance cameras are on."*
- Section 5:** The Dean of Students will enforce disciplinary action when needed.
- Section 6:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.




