**An Act to Add an Honors Program Student Representative to the Student Government Association Senate**

- Whereas,** the Honors Program serves approximately 300 students at Tennessee Technological University, **and,**
- Whereas,** the academic and extracurricular needs of Honors students are unique and deserve representation, **and,**
- Whereas,** currently, there is no guaranteed representation in the Student Government Association Senate for this population **and,**
- Whereas,** the purpose of the Student Government Association is to provide a voice for all students on campus.

**NOW THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT**

- Section 1: This bill shall be known as the “Honors Program Representation Act of 2022”.
- Section 2: Article V.B.3.ii.6, which shall be created, of the SGA Constitution, shall read: “Honors Program (HP) – 1 Senator”.
- Section 3: The Senator representing the Honors Program shall be elected by the student membership of the Honors Program during the second half of the spring semester for the upcoming year.
- Section 4: This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.


