- a. Swearing in of Cheyenne Bare as SGA Treasurer
  - i. The Oath of Office was administered.
  - ii. Cheyenne Bare took office as Treasurer.
- b. Senate Confirmations (Academic Senators)
  - i. Sen. Kashaina Nucum moved that all nominees for Academic Senators be considered as a slate, which was seconded. Without objection, the motion is adopted. The following nominees were considered as a slate:

- d. Bills and Resolutions
  - i. S.B. F24-001 Policies Manual Organization Act of 2024 Sen. Maya Seitz
    - 1. Sen. Seitz gave opening remarks on S.B. F24-001. Subsequentially, Sen. Seitz moved that the Senate adopt the aforementioned bill, which was seconded.
    - 2. After a period of debate, the bill passed with 19 members voting Aye, 0 members voting No, and 0 members abstaining.
  - ii. S.B. F24-002 Student Representation on University Standing Committees Act of 2024 - Sen. Maya Seitz
    - 1. Sen. Seitz gave opening remarks on S.B. F24-001. Subsequentially, Sen. Seitz moved that the Senate adopt the aforementioned bill, which was seconded.
    - 2. As there was no debate, Speaker Simpson closed debate and moved the chamber into a period of voting on S.B. F24-002.
    - 3. The bill passed with 20 members voting Aye, 0 members voting No, and 0 members abstaining.
  - iii. S.B. F24-003 Constitutional Cabinet Officers (Duties) Act of 2024 Sen. Zak Henson
    - 1. Sen. Henson gave opening remarks on S.B. F24-001. Subsequentially, Sen. Henson moved that the Senate adopt the aforementioned bill, which was seconded.
    - 2. As there was no debate, Speaker Simpson closed debate and moved the chamber into a period of voting on S.B. F24-003.

- 3. The bill passed with 20 members voting Aye, 0 members voting No, and 0 members abstaining.
- iv. S.B. F24-004 First Judiciary Act of 2024 Sen. Zak Henson
  - 1. Sen. Henson gave opening remarks on S.B. F24-001. Subsequentially, Sen. Henson moved that the Senate adopt the aforementioned bill, which was seconded.
  - 2. As there was no debate, Speaker Simpson closed debate and moved the chamber into a period of voting on S.B. F24-003.
  - 3. The bill passed with 20 members voting Aye, 0 members voting No, and 0 members abstaining.
- e. Executive Cabinet Confirmations
  - i. Sen. Kashaina Nucum moved that all nominees for the Executive Cabinet be considered as a slate, which was seconded. Without objection, the following nominees were considered as a slate:

  - iii. The nominees were confirmed with 20 members voting Aye, 0 members voting No, and 0 members abstaining.
