Attorney General Tidwell announced that the Judiciary Selection Committee had been reformed to fill the two vacancies on the Court. Attorney General Tidwell

continued and asked Justices to inform potential candidates to reach out to the chair of the Judiciary Selection Committee, SGA President Hale.

In accordance with the orders of the day, Chief Justice Lee declared the Supreme Court **ADJOURNED** until February 6th, 2024, after the adjournment of the Student Citation Appeals Committee without objection at 7:28pm.
