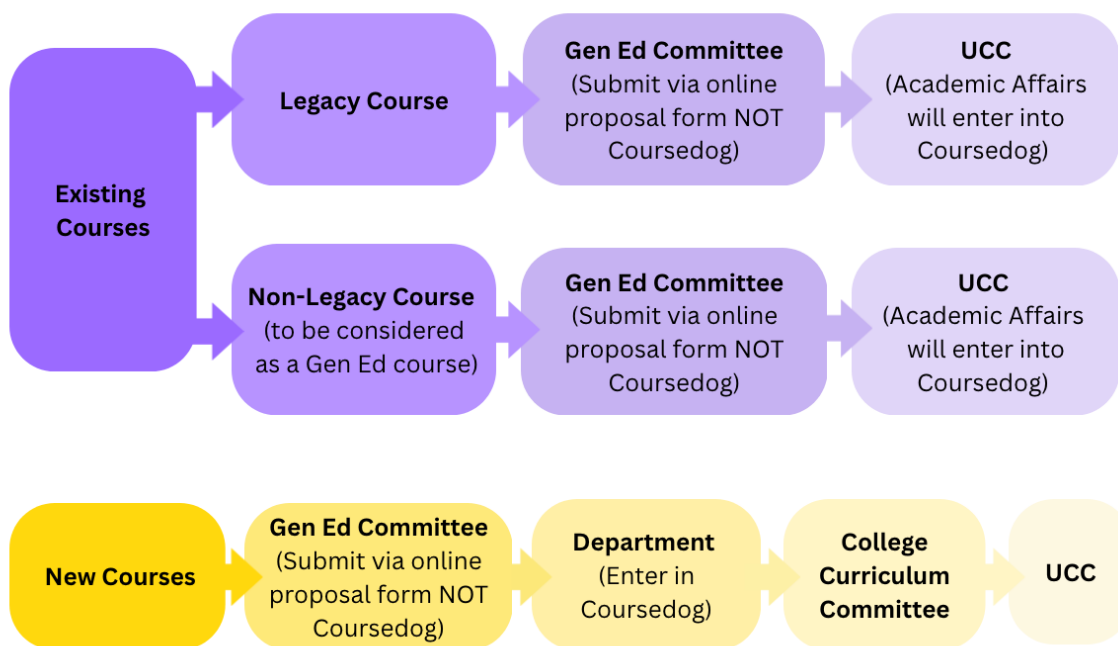


Implementation Plan for the New General Education Curriculum

(April 2025)

- All Legacy Courses (previously approved as General Education courses) & New Digital/Financial courses should be approved by the General Education Committee (Gen Ed Committee) by the end of the Fall Semester 2025.
- All updated programs of study should be approved by the University Curriculum Committee (UCC) by the end of the Spring semester of 2026.
- Courses to be considered for the Digital/Financial category should be offered (if possible) as 1-, 2-, and/or 3-credit courses (should be proposed as separate courses, not credit-hour ranges).
