ESTIMATED PERSONAL EXPENSES

Students are responsible for all their personal expenses including:

Fees required for special classes (ex. computer, language, science lab fees), books, local transportation, entertainment, etc. The amount below is provided as a guide; the actual amount needed will vary depending on courses and personal habits. There is a local bus service which TTU students can use at no cost.

Your personal expenses per month, including books, are estimated at:

\$250/month personal expenses

Plus \$500 per semester for books and supplies.
