

Definitions	Identifies the major operational unit within the institution responsible for the transaction.	Represents the academic, administrative, or operating unit responsible for or affected by a given transaction.	Individual pot(s) of money that is budgeted for or funded and spent against. (tracks source and use)	High-level classification used to categorize and report on the overall restrictions and designation of the Fund (Net Asset Class)	Categorizes the nature of the transaction as a specific type of revenue, expense, asset, liability, or fund balance.	Used to designate the F&A cost / NACUBO classification or mission. Meaningful value required only for expenses. (current "Program")	Records transactions with a <u>formalized</u> set of on-going cross disciplinary or department activities.	Used to understand the costs and/or revenues generated by a particular activity or event.	Tracks revenue and expense activities to a specific operating location such as a building, campus, etc.	Configured and left blank for future use.	Recording off-set entity on due to and due from entries for cross-entity transactions.

Validations within the Chart of Accounts

Related Value Set (RVS)

- Used to **manage dependencies between chart segments**.
- A segment's list of values displayed is based on the preceding segment selection.
- It's a mechanism to **ensure valid combinations** are used during data entry.



Think:
Proactive!

Examples:

- Fund and Fund Type
- Organization and Functional Class

Cross-Validation Rule (CVR)

- Defines a **value** of a particular segment that can be **combined** with specific values of other segments.
- Prevents the **creation** of combinations that **should not exist**.




Think:
Reactive!

Examples:

- Functional Class 999 - Balance Sheet can only be used with asset, liability or net position Accounts (100000 through 400000).
- Expense transactions (accounts that start with a 6 or 7) must use a valid functional class (cannot be 980 or 999).

Note: Both RVS and CVR rules are part of the CoA Validation services.

Thorough step-by-step instructions guiding end users how to perform specific tasks and processes.




Oracle Guided Learning
