As Tech's campus begins another exciting and busy academic year, the Talon project team is finishing the "foundation" phase of the project, and the "define" phase of the project will soon begin.

In this phase, project team members will work to outline current business processes for HR, finance and the business office to identify opportunities for process improvements, streamlining and the use of best practices to configure the Talon system so it is optimized to take full advantage of its capabilities.

During this phase, various stakeholders from across the campus will be asked to participate in discovery sessions to provide input, share information and help the project team understand processes from their vantage points.

BIG NEWS: Changes to payroll frequency are coming!

In response to the campus-wide survey conducted earlier this year, we are excited to announce the transition to a bi-weekly payroll frequency for all non-exempt hourly paid employees (students, graduate assistants, temporary employees, and clerical staff employees) when Talon is implemented!

Pay will be issued every two weeks based on hours worked. With this comes more frequent pay, shorter wait times for pay adjustments (e.g., retroactive adjustments, the start of pay, etc.) and a predictable pay schedule.

Faculty and exempt staff employees will stay on a monthly pay frequency. However, the payroll cutoff for entry items will be moved to the 25th of the month instead of the 15th of the month. Pay will still occur at the end of the month, but with a shorter period for variance, payroll changes and entry items will be easier to capture.

Payroll will also have the ability to process and pay an individual payroll outside the normally scheduled payroll when needed. Employees will no longer be asked to wait for the next monthly payroll for significant payroll items outside of the normal pay schedule. Payroll dashboards will also be available at your fingertips to see your personal payroll information, as well as for those employees for whom you approve time for and the budgets you manage.
